The University of Texas-Pan American is pleased to present the 2014-2015 UTPA Excellence and Departmental Scholarships. These scholarships are funded through a variety of memorials and endowments. Recipients are selected on a competitive basis and the funds are administered through the UTPA Scholarship Office.

Scholarships will be awarded on an annual basis and divided equally between Fall 2014 and Spring 2015 semesters.

All UTPA students and high school seniors are encouraged to apply starting Sept. 1, 2013. The UTPA Excellence and Departmental Scholarships application must be submitted online by Jan. 15, 2014. UTPA recipients will be notified before the end of March 2014.

Scholarship Criteria:

- Most are available to all majors.
- Full-time enrollment status, depending on classification.
- Most require U.S. citizenship or legal permanent resident status (international students are still encouraged to apply).
- Awards range from \$250 to \$3,200 annually.
- Scholarships are not automatically renewed; students must reapply each year.
- Open to all classifications, undergraduate and graduate.

How To Apply:

Important Note for Entering Freshmen: In order to qualify for a UTPA Excellence Scholarship, students are required to apply for admission to UTPA.

- Submit your admissions application online at www.applytexas.org.
- Submit a high school transcript with GPA (a 100-point scale), rank and class size, and ACT or SAT scores.
- Priority is given to students who have not already received an institutional scholarship.

In order for your scholarship application to be considered complete, please ensure the following two documents have been completed online:

- 1. One letter of recommendation from a teacher, professor or counselor.
 - 2. A 250-word essay (optional for certain scholarships).






University Scholars Program*

If you are an entering freshman who has earned college credit through Advanced Placement (AP) examinations and/or the Concurrent Enrollment (CE) program at The University of Texas-Pan American, or are an International Baccalaureate Diploma recipient, you may qualify for a four-year renewable scholarship. You may qualify to receive the University Scholars Presidential Award valued at \$24,000 or a University Scholars Meritorious Award valued at \$16,000.

Scholarship Requirements:

You can qualify for the University Scholars Scholarship by meeting the initial award guidelines and fulfilling the following requirements while in high school:



Note: For Advanced Placement examinations, a score of 4 or higher is equal to a letter grade of B or higher.

^{*} Scholarship is contingent upon availability of institutional funds.

University Scholars Meritorious Award \$16,000 (\$4,000 per year) Renewable award for four years or until graduation, whichever occurs first. Student must enroll in a minimum 15 hours per semester, complete a minimum of 30 hours per academic year and maintain a minimum 3.0 cumulative institutional GPA in order to remain eligible. Four courses (12 hrs.) of AP Courses must include English Minimum 22 ACT or and/or CE credits earned at UTPA. 1301 or higher and Math 1340 1020 SAT Composite Requirements Earn a B or better in each course. or higher OR Receive International Minimum 22 ACT or 1020 SAT Composite *Composites do not include writing portion of ACT/SAT tests. Baccalaureate Diploma. Top 10 percent of graduating Minimum 26 ACT or 1170 SAT Composite class from an accredited public *Composites do not include writing portion of ACT/SAT tests. or private high school.

Note: For Advanced Placement examinations, a score of 4 or higher is equal to a letter grade of B or higher.

How to Apply

There is no formal application for the University Scholars Scholarship. The University Scholars Scholarship is awarded on a competitive basis on a first-come, first-served basis. There are limited slots available; therefore, you are highly encouraged to do the following as early as possible to ensure you are considered for the scholarship:

- Fill out the UTPA Admission Application at applytexas.org.
- Submit your ACT or SAT scores.
- Submit an official high school transcript to the UTPA Office of Admissions, which must include ACT or SAT scores, GPA (on a 100-point scale), and rank and class size (at time of application).
- Request your AP scores (if applicable) be sent directly to UTPA.
- You must be admitted to UTPA.

The University of Texas-Pan American Foundation and Valley Alliance of Mentors for Opportunitites and Scholarships (VAMOS) have partnered to create the VAMOS/ UTPA Endowed Scholarship Program. Scholarships are renewable for up to four years of undergraduate study, or until graduation, whichever comes first. Award amount will be determined by a student's unmet financial need, as determined by the UTPA Student Financial Services Office, not to exceed the annual amount awarded through the VAMOS Scholarship program, administered by the VAMOS Board of Directors. All high school seniors are encouraged to apply starting Sept. 1, 2013. The application must be submitted online by Feb. 15, 2014

Eligibility Requirements

- a. Be a high school senior graduating in Spring and planning to attend The University of Texas-Pan American for the upcoming Fall semester.
- b. Be a U.S. citizen or an eligible non-citizen.
- c. Be a senior graduating from any high school in Hidalgo, Cameron or Starr County, Texas.
- d. Rank in the top 25 percent of his/her graduating class.
- e. Demonstrate financial need and be Pell Grant eligible as determined by the UTPA Student Services Financial Office and defined by the U.S. Department of Education using the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid).

First Generation Scholars Program

Due to the generosity of the Coca-Cola Foundation, we have created the Coca-Cola First Generation Scholars program at UT Pan American. The scholarships are renewable for up to four years of undergraduate study, or until graduation, whichever comes first. Recipients must maintain a 2.8 cumulative institutional GPA to continue in the program. The program will target incoming freshmen whose parents or siblings have not attended a college or university prior to the applicant's enrollment at UTPA. Award amount will be up to \$6,125 annually.

All high school seniors are encouraged to apply starting Sept. 1, 2013. The application must be submitted online by Jan. 15, 2014.

Eligibility Requirements

- a. Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident.
- b. Be admitted as an entering freshman at UTPA for the upcoming Fall semester.
- c. Must have a minimum 3.0 high school GPA.
- d. Must NOT have a parent or sibling who has already attended a college or university.
